

The St. Francis community thanks the Geiger Foundation for their recent donations to the St. Francis Fire and Police Departments.

The Geiger Foundation on December 14th, presented additional funds to Mayor CoryAnn St. Marie-Carls, Police Chief Tom Dietrich, Police Captain Kevin Hunter and Fire Chief Nick Poplar which now brings their total donation to \$46,000 to the City of St. Francis.

Geiger Foundation Board member, Terre Kent made the donation presentation, "I am thrilled to help St. Francis with these donations, my compliments go out to Mayor CoryAnn St. Marie-Carls for helping us focus our support on the needs of St. Francis, she went the extra mile on this", stated Kent. "Chief Dietrich, Chief Poplar as well as Captain Hunter have been excellent to work with in this process, they are a great team that we appreciate", remarked Kent.

The funds presented December 14th, by the Geiger Foundation are earmarked to purchase a Utility Terrain Vehicle for St. Francis Police and Fire in its entirety, including a specified automated external deliberator; additional monies are earmarked to pay for certification and training costs so Child Car Seat installation service can again be provided by our St. Francis Firefighters.

Terre Kent made another announcement at the meeting, "Mayor CoryAnn has helped us involve other partners in this funding effort and when the UTV vehicle arrives in 2018 we will plan a big unveiling inviting all involved in supporting this", announced Kent.

The Foundation is also partnering with the FBI Milwaukee Citizens Academy Alumni Association in continuing support for further Police and Fire fundraising efforts such as, "St. Francis Night at the Admirals" February 3rd. "Tickets are \$20.00 and the Admirals give \$4.00 back to our community, our goal is to get the community out in a show of support for efforts like that of the Geiger Foundation and other partners that have helped our Police and Fire so much already," stated St. Francis Mayor CoryAnn St. Marie-Carls. The Geiger Foundations first project of support for St. Francis was a PFCRB, Post Fire Carcinogen Reduction Booth, which has proved to be a valuable asset to reduce toxins from the skin of Firefighters not only in St. Francis but for others on the South Shore.
