Batman The Brave and Bold Season One, Volume One The Dark Knight returns for explosive action and humor in this four-episode collection from the all-new animated series. Venturing outside Gotham City, Batman (voiced by Diedrich Bader) battles fearsome foes with his endless arsenal of crime-fighting gadgets. The titular superhero teams with Green Arrow, Aquaman and other DC heroes in "Rise of the Blue Beetle," "Terror on Dinosaur Island," "Evil Under the Sea" and "Invasion of the Secret Santas." *Warner*

Fringe Season Two Return to explore the boundaries of a mysterious mythology that holds millions of viewers in its hypnotic grasp. Season 2 of Fringe contains worlds (and alternate worlds) of excitement complete with shape shifters, cryonic heads, belly-dwelling beasts and people who turn to ashes before our eyes. But the overarching narrative takes three clandestine FBI agents - Olivia Dunham, Peter Bishop and Walter Bishop - through a mind-bending investigation of a parallel reality that threatens to destroy ours. Harry Brown Set in modern day Britain, Harry Brown follows one man's journey through a chaotic world where drugs are the currency of the day and guns run the streets. A modest law-abiding citizen, Harry Brown is a retired Marine and a widower who lives alone on a depressed housing estate. His only company is his best friend Leonard (David Bradley). When Leonard is murdered by a gang of thugs, Harry feels compelled to act and is forced to dispense his own brand of justice. As he bids to clean up the run-down estate where he lives, his actions bring him into conflict with the police, led by investigating officer DCI Frampton (Emily Mortimer) and Charlie Creed-Miles. *Sony*

Good Fortune Filmmaker Landon Van Soest profiles three poverty-stricken Kenyans to illustrate how the West's well-intentioned aid to Africa -- to the tune of more than \$2 trillion over the last 50 years sometimes harms the individuals it's intended to help. Environmental policies restrict Oketch's fishing opportunities; Jackson's farm is threatened by agricultural development; and Silvia may lose her home and business when a squatter slum is "upgraded." *PBS*

Lafayette The Lost Hero The marquis de Lafayette (Patrick Bauchau) was a French aristocrat turned distinguished American general and statesman, yet he is remembered mainly by way of the towns that bear his name. This searching documentary uncovers the story of democracy's forgotten father. A soldier at 19, drafter of the Declaration of the Rights of Man, prisoner of war these are but a few of the milestones that mark Lafayette's illustrious and stormy career. *PBS*

When Worlds Collide Exploring the roots of Latino culture, this thought-provoking documentary transports viewers to the intersection of two vastly different worlds -- the "Old World" of European Spain and the "New World" of the Americas. Stops along the way include the Cerro del Tepeyac of Our Lady of Guadalupe in Mexico, the bustling city of Granada in Spain's Andalusia region, and Philip II's Escorial palace outside of Madrid. *PBS*

The Wall A World Divided Freedom With insights from political leaders like George H.W. Bush, Mikhail Gorbachev and Condoleezza Rice, explore the origins and demise of the notorious Berlin Wall, the structure's affect on ordinary German lives and the peaceful end to the Cold War. Full of detailed information, this historical PBS documentary explains the stark differences between East and West Germany and their process of reunification. *PBS*

Secrets of the Great Barrier Reef This 50 minute show includes awesome views of sea corals and life under the surface of the Australian sea. A few nights after the November full moon, when the water temperature and tides are in exactly the right phase, one of the most extraordinary events of the natural world can be witnessed. This is a synchronised dance that happens at precisely the same time along the entire 2,000-kilometre length of Australia's Great Barrier Reef. As if on cue, a vast array of coral species prepare to cast their tiny eggs and sperm into the surrounding water. At this very moment, the ocean begins to resemble an upside down snow storm as a blizzard of coral gametes are released and gently float to the surface and drift away in the currents, colonising reefs as far as the eye can see and beyond. *Infinity/Smithsonian*.

Ground War Tells the stories behind the key technological advances and strategic breakthroughs that have driven and been driven by thousands of years of ground warfare. Each episode will focus on an area where technology and science have influenced the unfolding evolution of ground combat. Programs include Warrior Weapons, Battlefield Mobility, Firepower and Command and Control. *PBS*

Unforgettable: The Korean War Shedding light on soldiers' memories of an "un-won" war, this penetrating program takes its cues from Korean War veterans who recall memories both painful and patriotic, putting a human face on an often forgotten conflict. Stories include wartime recollections, such as one soldier's first moments seeing a MiG fighter up close, and veterans' often-tragic experiences returning home, where Americans largely neglected to welcome them back. *PBS*

Chance Harris (Collins Pennie) just can't seem to focus on dancing, and who can blame him: his family life is a mess, his relationship with his girlfriend is on the rocks, and now a street gang is out to teach him a lesson for failing to pay on a lingering debt. In order to win the competition, Chance will have to put all of his problems aside and focus on leading his troupe to victory. Rock Prophecies Photographer Robert Knight has been capturing rock & roll history through his camera lens since the late '60s, snapping some of the earliest appearances of Jimi Hendrix, Led Zeppelin, and the Rolling Stones. But not content to be merely a classic-rock dinosaur, Knight continues to champion and mentor early-21st century musicians like the Australian band Sick Puppies and Texan guitarist Tyler Dow Bryant. This documentary from filmmaker John Chester chronicles Knight's amazing life and career in rock music and features interviews with many of his admirers (and frequent subjects), including Slash, Def Leppard, ZZ Top, Santana, Jeff Beck, and Steve Vai. *PBS*

Mount St Helens Back From The Dead The May 18, 1980 eruption of Mt. St. Helens - a strato-volcano in southeastern Washington State - still checks in as the single most economically devastating volcanic catastrophe in the history of the U.S. The casualties were scarcely limited to dollars, though: 57 people died, untoward numbers of animals perished, and the eruption devastated hundreds of square miles of surrounding geographic territory and wiped out homes and businesses. But perhaps the biggest shock arrived in the years to follow: in lieu of remaining desolate as many had predicted, the area around the mountain witnessed a resurgence in plant and animal life, until the crater itself eventually became active once again. As written, produced and directed by Nick Davidson and aired on PBS as an episode of its groundbreaking Nova series, this documentary special draws on such resources as magnetic mapping, GPS and much more to ask incisive questions about the forces causing these geological and environmental shifts forces that may lie rooted in a hidden patchwork of faults far beneath the mountain's surface, and that could easily help geologists predict future eruptions. *PBS*

Amount The Righteous MacNeil-Lehrer Productions and the journalist-cum-think tank leader Robert Satloff teamed up to create this unique documentary, directed by William Cran and adapted from a tome by Satloff. The program begins with a key question: given the breadth of Holocaust denial within the Arabic universe, did any Arabs play key roles in rescuing Jews from Nazi annihilation? Satloff sets out to find an Arab hero who filled this role; in the process, he not only found several of these individuals but uncovered a fascinating "lost history" concerning what happened to over 500,000 Jewish men and women who occupied the Arabic lands of North Africa just prior to the Second World War.
