He speaks a smattering of Mandarin and, it's revealed in an episode here, Greek as well. The Actor's Studio-trained Boone seems to have been the creative driving force behind the series in its later seasons, though many of its qualities were first established in episodes written or directed by rising talents as varied as Sam Peckinpah and Gene Roddenberry. The intellectual, often even existential writing on the show is frequently self-conscious in a Rod Serling sort of earnestness, but it's hard not to admire its enormous ambitions, especially by TV Western standards. Saddle up for *Have Gun Will Travel Season 5, Volume Two* - a thrilling 3-disc set containing the final 19 episodes from the fifth season of this classic TV series. Paladin (Richard Boone), knows countless languages, is a master of the fighting arts, and one of the fastest guns in the West. He appreciates fine food, beautiful women, and the refined lifestyle of San Francisco's Carlton Hotel. But, at a moment's notice, this legendary gunslinger will hit the trail, daring to do what few men would...or could. From the sun-baked corners of the desolate desert to the hardscrabble homesteads of desperate squatters, Paladin always gets the job done in the awesome adventures of Season Five, Volume Two. *CBS/Paramount*

**The Stranger** Orson Welles directed and starred in *The Stranger*, a tense black-and-white thriller that Welles made for maverick producer Sam Spiegel. Welles portrays Charles Rankin, a respected academic at a prominent Connecticut college. He seems to have the perfect life: a beautiful new wife, Mary (Loretta Young); and a charming home in a small town that holds him in high esteem. Enter Mr. Wilson (Edward G. Robinson), a detective on the hunt for Nazi war criminal Franz Kindler. The appearance of Mr. Wilson threatens to reveal that underneath this idyllic veneer is a secret that could tear everything apart. Although many of Welles's most interesting scenes wound up on the cutting-room floor when Spiegel reedited the film, *The Stranger* is still multi-layered, complex, and fascinating. The scenes between Welles and Robinson are intellectually gripping, leading up to the stylized, shocking conclusion. As with so many of Welles's films, he was unhappy with the final result, but the viewer won't be. It would be most interesting to see the film as Welles intended it to be, but in the meantime, this version of *The Stranger* is a marvel *Virgil Films*

**S.W.A.T. Firefight** Los Angeles S.W.A.T. officer, Lt. Paul Cutler (Macht), is sent to train the Detroit S.W.A.T. team on new anti-terrorism and homeland security techniques. Cutler has a hard time settling into his assignment as he locks horns with his new captain and encounters resistance from the team he must lead. Cutler begins to adjust to his new assignment, starting a budding romance with police psychologist Kim Byers (Pope) along the way. Unexpectedly, a routine hostage call turns deadly, and a relentless ex-government agent named Walter Hatch (Patrick) vows revenge on Cutler and the entire S.W.A.T. team for killing the woman he loves. Cutler must use his considerable S.W.A.T. training and knowledge to save his teammates and defeat a trained killer. The film also stars Giancarlo Esposito as Cutler's reluctant Detroit S.W.A.T. team leader. *Sony*

**127 Hours** James Franco stars in director Danny Boyle's inspiring survival drama based on the incredible true story of Aron Ralston, who became trapped alone in a Utah canyon for days after slipping on a loose rock, and resorted to extraordinary measures in order to make it out of his dire predicament alive. An experienced hiker and climber, Ralston (Franco) is very much in his element when he parks his truck by a mountain near Moab, UT, hops on his bike, and peddles to the middle of nowhere. Later, when Ralston encounters a pair of young female hikers who have gotten lost while searching for a local landmark, he jovially shows them a sight that most casual hikers miss before bidding them farewell and continuing on his way. Drifting through the canyons alone, deep in thought, however, the explorer who presumed he was ready for anything quickly discovers just how fast things can spin out of control when a rock gives way as he shimmies down a crevice, and pins his hand to the unforgiving wall of stone. Over the course of the next 172 hours, Ralston tries everything he can think of to free himself, flashing back to small but memorable events in his life - as well as forward to the future that he might enjoy should he manage to wiggle free as his body begins the slow process of shutting down. Eventually realizing that the only way out is to leave part of himself behind, the exhausted, delirious adventurer draws his cheap made-in-China multi-tool, and does what it takes to survive. *Fox*

**The Reef** In this undersea animated treat, orphaned fish Pi (voiced by Freddie Prinze Jr.) bids farewell to Boston Harbor for a new life with his psychic aunt (Fran Drescher) in the Caribbean, where he promptly falls for the beautiful angelfish Cordelia (Evan Rachel Wood). But a nasty shark (Donal Logue) also has his sights set on Cordelia, and little Pi needs a big plan if he wants to save the day and get the girl in this aquatic family adventure. *Genius*

**Battle of the Warriors** A mysterious stranger must rescue the kingdom of Liang. A lone hero comes to the rescue of a village about to be overrun by a marauding army in this historical epic from Hong Kong. In the year 370 B.C., China has been torn apart by a handful of warring factions, and the Zhao State has set out on a long march to invade and conquer the Yan State. En route, the 10,000-strong Zhao army will pass through the town of Liang City, home to 4,000 souls. Led by Lord Liang (Wang Zhiwen), an ineffectual and alcoholic leader, the people of Liang City fear the worse, and beg the warriors of the Mozi clan to come to their aid in protecting the city. As Zhao general Xiang Yanzhong (Ahn Sung-ki) and his men loom on the horizon, a single Mozi fighter, Ge Li (Andy Lau), arrives in Liang City; while the townspeople are certain the battle is already lost, Li is a brilliant strategist and convinces the handful of Liang soldiers that they can indeed fend off the Zhao invaders. With the help of Liang cavalry woman Yi Yue (Fan Bingbing) and Zi Tuan (Nicky Wu), a master of the bow and arrow, Li is able to fight the Zhao soldiers to a standstill. However, Lord Liang is humiliated by the success of the interloper, and his right-hand man (Wu Ma) plants seeds of doubt in the villagers' minds about their new champion. *Dragon Dynasty*

**John Wayne: Bigger Than Life**: McLintock/The American West of John Ford. As this is by no means a revisionist western, McLintock's chauvinistic attempts to "tame" his wife fit within the problematic ideology of the larger western genre.
