The Untouchables Season 2, Volume 2 Thirty years before they hit the big screen via Brian DePalma's brilliant movie adaptation, Eliot Ness's legendary exploits came to life in the classic 1950s and '60s television series *The Untouchables*. Created by veteran crime-drama producer Quinn Martin, the series followed Ness (Robert Stack) and his team of crack crimefighters—including agents Martin Flaherty (Jerry Paris), Jack Rossman (Steve London), Enrico Rossi (Nicholas Georgiade), and William Youngellow (Abel Fernandez)—as they took on the Mafia underworld of gangsters Al Capone (Neville Brand) and Frank Nitti (Bruce Gordon) in Prohibition-era Chicago. Smart and iconic, the series distinguished itself with superb voiceover narration from broadcaster Walter Winchell and a gritty style that nonetheless eschewed graphic depictions of gore and violence. Everybody Hates Chris 3rd Season Comedian Chris Rock parleys his real-life childhood experiences into an endearingly family-friendly coming-of-age sitcom with the popular and critically acclaimed *Everybody Hates Chris*. Set in 1980s Bed-Stuy, Brooklyn (where Rock himself grew up), the series follows teenage Chris (Tyler James Williams) as his efforts at being cool are constantly stifled by his penny-pinching father, Julius (former NFL player Terry Crews); overprotective mother, Rochelle and annoying younger siblings, Drew (Tequan Richmond) and Tanya (Imani Hakim). Rock himself provides the voiceover narration, while period-piece detail and an impeccable soul soundtrack add authentic '80s nostalgia. Whether you call it an African-American *Wonder Years* or a working-class *Cosby Show*, *Everybody Hates Chris* is funny, creative, clever, and full of heart—and one of the best television series to come around in quite a while. The Office Season 4 In the hilarious and cringe-worthy fourth season of The Office, Ryan "The Temp" Howard (B.J. Novak) moves up to the Dunder Mifflin corporate headquarters, sweethearts Pam (Jenna Fischer) and Jim (John Krasinski) go public with their long-awaited romantic relationship, and Dwight (Rainn Wilson), salesman geek extraordinaire, bristles as his ex-girlfriend, Angela (Angela Martin), is wooed away by the obnoxious Andy (Ed Helms). Of course, overseeing it all is self-proclaimed "World's Greatest Boss," Michael Scott, played by Steve Carell with a terrific obliviousness that rings painfully true to cubicle dwellers everywhere. Fresh from an Emmy win for Outstanding Comedy Series, the 2007-08 season of the workplace mockumentary delves even further into the tedium of daily office life, including the company's struggle to enter the "digital age," the production of a local TV commercial, and the constant threat of a bored-employee insurrection. The Scorpion King 2 Rise of a Warrior Uncovers the origins of the 2002 summer blockbuster which starred Dwayne "The Rock" Johnson as Mathayus, the most fearsome desert warrior of the ancient world. Reaching deep into the past, this prequel begins with the king as a 13-year-old peasant boy (Michael Copon) who witnesses the kidnapping and death of his father at the hands of the terrifying Sargon (played by towering UFC Heavyweight Randy Couture). Thirsty for vengeance, young Mathayus trains at the Order of the Black Scorpion to sharpen his skills as a killing machine, then journeys to the underworld to retrieve the one sword that can help him defeat Sargon. When the burgeoning Scorpion King finally comes to blows with his murderous rival, the fate of the entire human race hangs in the balance. *Universal*

Brotherhood of the Wolf Is a wild mix of martial arts, horror, and French period drama. Grégoire de Fronsac (Samuel Le Bihan), a charming naturalist and libertine, arrives in Gevaudan with his companion, Mani (Mark Dacascos), a taciturn Mohawk Iroquois Indian with amazing fighting skills. Fronsac has been sent by the king to investigate a mysterious beast that is slaughtering women and children across the countryside. The local gentry include the friendly Marquis Thomas D'Apcher (Jérémie Rénier), Jean-François de Morangias (Vincent Cassel), a one-armed adventurer with a suspicious nature, and his beautiful sister, Marianne. Though Fronsac is immediately attracted to Marianne, he still finds time to visit Sylvia (Monica Bellucci), a mysterious prostitute with a penchant for sharp objects. Fronsac and Mani quickly realize that the killer is not a wolf, but something bigger and far more deadly. As they attempt to track the beast, they encounter unexpected resistance from the locals, and find themselves in grave danger. *Universal*

Heroes Season 2 The dramatic twists in the fates of Heroes' super-powered everymen continue in this peril-packed second season. Volume two begins four months after the Emmy Award-nominated first season's explosive finale, just as the heroes are struggling, once again, to adapt to normal existence. Claire, an invincible cheerleader, and her mysterious guardian Noah (Jack Coleman) have adopted new identities and a different hometown. After a riveting first-season cliffhanger, Season 2 of this top-rated drama finds Hiro transported to 17th-century Japan and surrounded by samurai warriors just in time for a solar eclipse. Speed Racer Based on the 1960s Japanese-manga-derived animated TV series of the same name, Speed Racer follows the adventures of the title character (Emile Hirsch), a young race car driver who sits behind the wheel of the lightning-fast Mach 5 vehicle. Aided by his family, which includes Pops Racer (John Goodman) and Mom Racer (Susan Sarandon), and his devoted doe-eyed girlfriend, Trixie (Christina Ricci), Speed racks up victory after victory, but still lives in the shadow of his late older brother, Rex (Scott Porter), who died in a race. When Speed gamers the wrath of Royalton Industries, he must team up with the enigmatic Racer X (Matthew Fox) to defeat the ruthless corporation. *Universal*

Baby Mama Most romantic couples onscreen or otherwise--would kill for the type of chemistry that Tina Fey and Amy Poehler share in the gyno-centric comedy *Baby Mama*, even though the women are only playing friends. Fey stars as Kate, a 37-year-old vice president at an organic foods company whose womb starts a-kickin' every time she sees a baby. Though her career has kept her from marriage and children, she has decided that it's time for her to get pregnant. But multiple tries with in vitro fertilization leave her disappointed, and Kate turns to a surrogate mother. Enter Angie (Poehler), a high-school dropout desperate for the large check that comes with carrying someone's child. Though she agrees to be Kate's surrogate, it's clear that the women disagree on everything from music to the type of food Angie should be eating. When Angie leaves her apartment after a fight with her obnoxious common-law husband, she moves into Kate's posh Philadelphia apartment, and the women spend the rest of *Baby Mama* alternately battling and bonding. Steve Martin appears in a small but enjoyable role as Kate's oily boss, and Oscar nominee Greg Kinnear gets good mileage out of playing her love interest. *Universal*

Snow Angels Director David Gordon Green adds another carefully sculpted drama to his resume with *Snow Angels*. Green deposits a strong cast in a snowbound Pennsylvania town for his fourth full-length feature, which revolves around the troubled teenage life of young Arthur (Michael Angarano). Arthur divides his time between working at a Chinese restaurant and dealing with the break up of his parents. His endearing lack of self-confidence is tempered when new-girl-in-town Lila (Olivia Thirlby) shows a romantic interest in him. Meanwhile, Arthur's co-worker and former babysitter, Annie (Kate Beckinsale), is trying to raise her child alone after the failure of her marriage to the unhinged Glenn (Sam Rockwell). Annie also embarks on an unwise affair with Nate (Nicky Katt), who happens to be married to her best friend. Green's central characters try to make the best of their modest lives until a major incident, dropped halfway through the movie, raises the tension between Annie and Glenn to breaking point. Beckinsale, Rockwell, and Angarano all deliver consummate performances, and they are joined by a strong supporting cast that includes Griffin Dunne and a rare straight role for comedian Amy Sedaris. Green's style, so often compared to that of Terrence Malick, takes a slightly different turn here as the director delivers a relatively straightforward thriller. But the change suits him, and *Snow Angels* contains enough edge-of-your-seat tension to keep audiences curious as to where the director is going to take them. *Warner*

Kabluay Prendergast stars as Salman, a ne'er-do-well with no money and no place to live. He moves in with his sister-in-law, Leslie (Lisa Kudrow), promising to take care of her kids while she works; her husband (his brother), a member of the National Guard, is still in Iraq, his tour extended yet again. Unfortunately for Salman, his nephews, Lincoln (Landon Henninger) and Cameron (Cameron Wofford), are unholy, unstoppable terrors. Wanting him to get back on his own two feet, Leslie finds Salman a job at her very strange, hilariously absurd company, BlueNexion, where Salman must get inside a big blue costume and hand out flyers in the middle of a nearly deserted highway. But when he finds out a little too much about Leslie, he is put into an awkward situation that he's not sure he can get out of easily. *Sony*

Tortured Undercover FBI agent Jimmy Vaughn (Cole Hauser) is put to the ultimate test when he's ordered by a notorious crime boss to interrogate and torture a mob accountant (Laurence Fishburne) accused of stealing millions of dollars in dirty money. Nolan Lebovitz writes and directs this nail-biting thriller that features a stellar supporting cast, including James Cromwell, James Denton, Kevin James, Jon Cryer and Emmanuelle Chriqui. *Sony*

This American Life Public radio's award-winning *This American Life* makes a successful translation to television with this penetrating Showtime series. As with the radio program, Ira Glass hosts these themed episodes about the bizarre, inspiring, heartbreaking, and often hilarious lives of average Americans. The emphasis continues to be on the voices of people telling their stories in their own words; but the added visual element adds an important dimension to these tales that make the show much more than merely a retread of the radio version. This collection presents all six episodes of the first season of the show. *Paramount*

Criminal Minds Season 3 This popular show follows a group of FBI agents as they go inside the minds of vicious murderers. Tony Award-winner Joe Mantegna stars as David Rossi in this third season (replacing Mandy Patinkin), an original founder of the Behavioral Analysis Unit who returns to action as a profiler; in addition to Mantegna, *Criminal Minds* stars Thomas Gibson as the group's leader. Solving mysteries by delving into the psychology of serial killers and terrorists, each of the group's members are able to offer special insight into specific cases: Derek Morgan (Shemar Moore) helps to solve crimes of obsession; Penelope Garcia (Kirsten Vangsness) employs her computer skills to gather clues; and Spencer Reid (Matthew Gray Gubler) uses his considerable intelligence to crack cases, despite his substandard social skills. Offering insight into both real and fictional crimes, this show is an essential for drama devotees. This collection presents the complete third season. Blood Vision Morella's Graveyard Theater Three "bone chilling chillers" are included in this collection: *Zombies* (also known as *I Eat Your Skin*), *The Blood Seekers* and *The Blood Stalkers*. Each film is decidedly bad, but at least they're uniquely bad. The first (and oldest) film in the collection is *Zombies*, telling the story of an author/playboy who travels to a Caribbean island "so remote only one man knows its location" and discovers tribal sacrifices and a cover-up that can only be compared to an episode of *Scooby Doo*. There are actually a few decent scares here, mostly due to the black and white film masking much of the cheapness, and I actually think if this story was remade today with a little more money (and some better actors) it could have a chance to be legitimately frightening. *The Blood Seekers* is next, originally filmed in black and white and then tinted to look like it's in color, or what Morella calls, Super Spectra Chroma Color Vision. Our hostess is sure to remind us before this one starts that there are no refunds, and it's a good thing she does. This is easily the weakest film of the bunch, centering around a mysterious group of vampiric murders and a detective brought to the Philippines and hired to follow the clues and track down the killer. The final film, sans introduction by Morella for some reason, is *Blood Stalkers*, a slowly paced mixture between *The Hills Have Eyes* and *House of 1,000 Corpses*. The grainy color film helps provide ambience to the story, but there's not much plot to go on. A group of friends travels to a cabin in the Everglades to visit an old run-down cabin (and I do mean run-down) before being ambushed by a ragtag group of bumpkin thugs. The night scenes are hardly lit at all and the acting is pretty appalling, but there's something about the grittiness of the film that's endearing. Overall, this is the kind of collection that only diehard horror fans will really dive into. All three of these films feel like they should have a Mystery Science Theatre commentary track providing background humor to some of the more obviously silly plot points. It's an occasionally silly/ occasionally entertaining ride, but hey it's all tongue-in-cheek and you don't expect true horror when you buy a DVD that boasts "5 Hours Of Sleep Defying Thrills."
