Eddie Morra (Bradley Cooper) is an author without a novel. No matter how hard he tries, he just can't summon the inspiration to write a single word. That all changes when an old friend wanders back into Eddie's life, and opens his eyes to a powerful new drug called NZT. The moment Eddie takes NZT, his brain begins functioning at 100 percent, giving him the ability to quickly recall every event in his life down to the smallest detail, learn new languages in a flash, and harness the untapped power of complex mathematical equations. But when Eddie's supply of NZT runs out, the party is over. Rawhide: 4th Season Vol. 1 One of the most popular western series of the post-war years, CBS's *Rawhide* (1959-66) also introduced viewers to a young man who ultimately became a Hollywood icon: Clint Eastwood, just prior to his series of collaborations with Sergio Leone.
