In quick succession, Nick's lover turns up dead, Nick gets fingered for the crime and Victoria's left to pick up the pieces. *MTI*

Pig Hunt A guys-only hunting weekend hits a snag when John's (Travis Aaron Wade) girlfriend, Brooks (Tina Huang), crashes the party and turns out to be the best shooter of the gang. But this annoyance is nothing compared to the insanity ahead. Fields of marijuana, crazed hicks, a hippie commune, a 3,000-pound killer boar and other high jinks combine in this unique and unpredictable horror comedy. *Fangoria*

Fragile In this atmospheric thriller, American nurse Amy (Calista Flockhart) is thrust into an eerie and dangerous world when she takes a temporary job at an isolated children's hospital in England that's slated for closure. Dark House Trying to exorcise her worst memories, Claire (Meghan Ory) returns to the foster home where she witnessed a terrible massacre years ago. Capitalizing on its history, a mysterious showman (Jeffrey Combs) has turned the infamous mansion into a haunted-house attraction. Claire and her friends soon realize that a demonic force has taken over the building and they've been locked inside with a malevolent spirit who wants to perpetrate another mass murder. *Fangoria*

Hunger Five strangers awake in an underground dungeon and discover that they've been kidnapped as part of a terrible experiment. A sadistic scientist wants to answer a simple question: What are they willing to do to survive after weeks without food? As the days go by and their hunger becomes unbearable, the captives struggle to retain their humanity. Despite his initial resistance to Bud's entreaties, Gekko finally takes on the eager beaver as his protégé, schooling him in the kind of slash-and-burn maneuvers that have taken Gekko to the top. This style is far more attractive to Fox than the more prosaic but principled approach to investing preached by veteran Lou Mannheim (Hal Holbrook). And, at first, it's impossible to dispute his preference; as Bud's life moves into the fast lane, he quickly acquires an upscale apartment and a girlfriend to match, interior designer Darien (Darryl Hannah). But when Gekko demands that Bud not only break the law but directly undermine his union-leader father, Carl (Martin Sheen), and jeopardize the jobs and lives of his friends and family, he realizes that the cost of success might be more than he's willing to pay. Wall Street is a riveting, testosterone-fueled tour of the Street's upper echelons, featuring standout performances by Michael Douglas and Martin Sheen. *Fox*

Upon arriving on Malgor, Comet makes fast friends with a kind-hearted alien named Kilowatt. When the dreaded Zartog assumes command of Mission Control, it's up to Comet, Kilowatt, Ham, Luna, and Titan to overthrow the extraterrestrial tyrant. *Fox*

Robocop Trilogy Robocop In Paul Verhoeven's landmark sci-fi thriller, the monolithic corporation controlling a futuristic, crime-riddled Detroit transforms a dead cop (Peter Weller) into a cybernetic law-enforcement unit called RoboCop and soon the streets are safe. But as Robo cleans up the city, he seeks to avenge his death, and uncovers a conspiracy stretching from the back alleys to the boardroom of the company that reengineered him. Robocop 2 The sequel to 1987's sci-fi blockbuster brings back "The Future of Law Enforcement," RoboCop (Peter Weller), to face his greatest challenge ever. This time around, the half-human, half-machine police officer is out to rid Detroit of the deadly new designer drug Nuke. But his worries don't end there; seems the evil corporate empire that created RoboCop intends to develop a larger and more powerful version to replace the original. Robocop 3 Robert Burke dons the cyber-borg suit and becomes the law-abiding crime-fighter in this action thriller, the third of the series. Omni Consumer Products has taken a livable community and run it into the ground so they can raze it and construct the expensive Delta City. Unwilling to let go of their homes, the community's residents hope that Robocop will appear once again to save them from the greedy corporate behemoth before it's too late. *MGM*

Wild Grass Alain Resnais, one of the towering figures of the French New Wave, demonstrates he still has plenty to say in this drama based on a novel by Christian Gailly. Marguerite (Sabine Azéma) is a successful dentist with a busy practice and an offbeat hobby, flying small airplanes. One day, while running errands, Marguerite loses her wallet, and it's found by Georges (André Dussollier), a seemingly happy man with a wife, Suzanne (Anne Consigny), and two children (Vladimir Consigny and Sara Forestier). As Georges looks through the wallet and examines the photos of Marguerite, he finds he's fascinated with her and her life, and soon his curiosity about her becomes an obsession. Georges' attempts to integrate himself into Marguerite's life begin to alarm her, and she hires a private security team (Mathieu Amalric and Michel Vuillermoz) to keep him away, but Georges is determined. *Sony*

Romeo & Juliet This ambitious undertaking, adapting William Shakespeare's classic tale of star-crossed lovers and setting the story in a glossy music-video style in 1990s Florida. Leonardo DiCaprio and Claire Danes play the famous lovers kept apart by rival industrialist families. Bookended by newscasters reciting Shakespeare's prose as their copy, this clever glam updating of *Romeo and Juliet* is one of the most unusual adaptations of the Bard's work in the history of cinema. The stylish and colorful sets earned the film an Oscar nomination for art direction. John Leguizamo gives a memorable performance as a devilish Tybalt. *Fox*
